- 2. All applicants need at least two recommendations, of which at least one needs to be from a former teacher, and one not related to the applicant's education. Recommenders cannot be related to the applicant. Diversity of recommendations is strongly encouraged.
- 3. Recommendations should be in the recommender's own words. The recommendations must include the following:
 - a. Recommender's name, occupation and title, address, office phone, email address, length of time knowing the applicant.

- b. How the recommender knows the applicant and his or her knowledge of the applicant's background and achievements and a description of some or all the following attributes of the applicant:
 - 1. Maturity
 - 2. Integrity
 - 3. Morality
 - 4. Leadership
 - 5. Overall potential to succeed in the applicant's preferred field
